Several different mini colorways will be created for you so that you may play with variations on color themes.

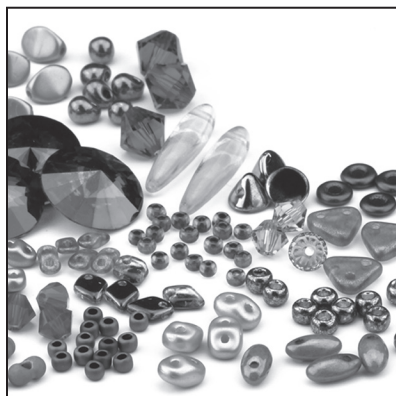
You will be able to use your color choices to create a beautiful garden as you bead various flowers and leaves and experience how the colors, finishes, and shapes interact.

Your color samples will be used to create either a finished project or as embellishments on an existing piece. You might choose a necklace, bracelet, pendant, or art piece, or you may choose to embellish a purse, your shoes, or even your cell phone case — whatever your heart deems is the perfect setting for your completed components.
